LOCATION

- Two blocks from shopping at Ghirardelli Square, featuring a working replica of an old-time chocolate making machine
- Near Pier 45, home to USS Pampanito (WWII submarine)
- Easy access to shopping at Pier 39 and the Alcatraz departure point at Pier 41
- Just steps from the beginning of the Golden Gate Promenade, stretching along the Bay from Fort Mason to Fort Point, located under the Golden Gate Bridge
- Proximity to other landmarks and points of interest
 - Across the street from the Hyde Street Cable Car terminus
 - Walking distance to North Beach, Telegraph Hill and Coit Tower
 - Easy access to Financial District
 - Close to the new Cruise Ship Terminal
