Hotel Setting

The only resort in the world situated at the convergence of five majestic canyons, Gateway Canyons Resort is located an hour southwest of Grand Junction, Colorado and two hours from the renowned Moab Desert of Utah. The resort is a resplendent of adobe-style southwestern architecture, tall cottonwood trees and irrigated green fields contrasting the red walls of the canyons that were once home to the ancient Puebloans.

Meetings & Events

Boasting more than 11,000 square feet of state-of-the-art meeting space, Gateway Canyons Resort features traditional boardroom and ballroom settings, a full HD theater, an outdoor amphitheater, atrium, private dining room and endless outdoor gathering sites - providing a variety of options for the ultimate group setting.

Palisade Event Center

The onsite LEED-certified Palisade Event Center provides groups with multiple meeting options, including the Old Sage Boardroom, 56-seat CUFesit, HD Theater, Storyteller Library, in addition to another 2,500 square feet of outdoor patios with the Grand Hall and Sunset Atrium.

Mission Bell Amphitheater

Reflecting the Pueblo Revival Style of the 1920s mixed with Roman-influenced architecture, the Mission Bell Amphitheater is an outdoor venue providing a large stage and ample seating, ideal for lectures, concerts, weddings and other special events.

Cottonwood Terrace

Just steps away from the Mission Bell Amphitheater, the shaded lawn of the Cottonwood Terrace is a wonderful, lush location for wedding ceremonies and extended festivities for up to 200 guests.

Gateway Auto Museum

Accommodating up to 75 people, the lobby of the Gateway Auto Museum provides an ideal setting for a range of events – from wedding receptions to rehearsal dinners – and can be paired with a private viewing of the Gateway Auto Museum, if desired.

For a slightly smaller reception, the front courtyard of the Gateway Auto Museum offers a spacious, outdoor setting, with plenty of room to accommodate up to 40 guests.

Paradox Grille Courtyard

Located behind the Paradox Grille, the courtyard offers the perfect casual settings for a cocktail party or private dinner, with seating available for approximately 50 guests.

Set against a spectacular background, the Gateway Ponds provide an ideal setting for up to 40 guests – whether hosting a wine and cheese paired evening, intimate ceremony or casual dinner reception.

Red Cliff Camp

Palisade Ranch

Palisade Ranch offers daily guided trail rides at the base of Uncompahgre Plateau, cattle drives, ranching education, roping lessons and some fun competition.

Horseback Riding

Spanning more than 500 acres with a generous network of well-marked Colorado horseback riding trails that climb over 1,500 feet in elevation, the facility provides spectacular access to the area's riches. Gateway Canyons' experienced guides will take you on an exploration of the base of the Uncompahgre Plateau, the surrounding picturesque desert and red rock canyons. Both beginners and advanced riders are sure to enjoy the ride.

Air Tours

Gateway Canyons Air Tours offers the unique and unforgettable experience of flying over some of the most spectacular scenery in the world! Guests can not only see the scenic beauty from under the beautiful blue skies of Colorado, but they learn about the fascinating lore and legends of western Colorado and eastern Utah. Gateway Canyons' Eurocopter AStar B3 offers exceptional visibility, range and power (84 7 horsepower engine), combined with a quiet cabin make it ideal for scenic tours. This helicopter has been appointed with leather seats, and a luxurious interior. Passengers are treated to state-of-the art, noise-cancelling Bose headsets for ease of conversation in the cabin and with the pilot.

Gateway Canyons Auto Museum

Featured among rare and historic automobiles at the Gateway Canyons Auto Museum is the 1954 Oldsmobile F-88 concept car. Filled with pristine examples of American automotive art, The Gateway Canyons Auto Museum is devoted to understanding and celebrating the history, design and social impact of the American automobile.
